

Bone-A-Fide Dog Ranch Information Sheet

All you need to know...

- We require a copy of current Rabies, DHLPP, Bordetella, and a negative fecal test. **The fecal test must be within the last 6 months.** If the fecal exam is not up to date, your dog will not be able to stay. We also require your dog to be on a regular flea control program. It is your responsibility to make sure we have the updated records prior to your dog's stay.
- Boarding dogs must be dropped off between 7:30am and 11:00 am Sunday-Friday, and between 7:30 am and 10 am on Saturday. Daycare dogs must be dropped off between 7:30am and 10am every day.** For the safety and comfort of all the dogs we want them to arrive as early as possible so they have plenty of time to get comfortable with the pack and make friends before bedtime.
- We don't allow dogs to be dropped off for their first day on a Saturday.
- Pick-ups at the ranch can be any time between 8:30 am and 6:00 pm. Boarding dogs picked up after 1:00 pm will be charged an additional daycare fee (\$30/dog).
- Dogs being bathed should be picked up after 10:00 am so they have time to dry.
- Have enough food for the length of your dog's visit. **If you are concerned about weight loss or if it's an extended stay, please increase their normal food portions.** If your dog normally doesn't eat away from home, back something extra special we can add to their food (cheese, chicken broth, etc).
- Include any medications and supplements with instructions about amount and frequency. Please keep these medications separate from the food.
- Please let us know if your dog has any specific health issues we should know about (e.g. seizures, allergies, arthritis, prone to ear infections, etc). Also provide us with any additional information you feel necessary to ensure the comfort of your dog (e.g. shy of men, scared of loud noises, etc).
- We have plenty of bowls, measuring cups, beds, and leashes, so keep these with you so they do not get destroyed or lost at the ranch.
- Please make sure your dog is wearing a clip or buckle style collar. Slip collars and prong collars can be dangerous in a play environment. We recommend removing any tags from your dog's collar, they sometimes get lost during play. We will put one of our tags on their collar.
- If your dog is getting picked up from Bone-A-Fide by someone other than yourself (taxi service, family member, etc.) please contact our office in advance to make arrangements for payment. We will happily accept your credit card over the phone or you can prepay at the beginning of the stay.
